

“Q1 2007 Internet Banking and Bill Pay End User” Sweepstakes
OFFICIAL RULES

NO PURCHASE OR PAYMENT OF ANY KIND IS NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN THIS SWEEPSTAKES. A PURCHASE WILL NOT INCREASE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING.

ELIGIBILITY: To enter the “Q1 2007 Internet Banking and Bill Pay End User” Sweepstakes (the “Sweepstakes”), you must be: (A) a lawful permanent resident of the United States, 18 years of age or older with a unique, personal and valid social security number and must not be considered a minor in your state of residence. Sweepstakes is void in Puerto Rico, U.S. territories and possessions, outside of the United States, and where restricted or prohibited by law. Employees of Digital Insight Corporation (the “Sponsor”) and participating financial institutions, their affiliated companies, parents, subsidiaries, service partners, and advertising and promotion agencies (collectively, “Sweepstakes Entities”), and their IRS dependents, immediate families (i.e. parents, children, siblings, spouse) and members of their households (whether related or not) are ineligible to participate in this Sweepstakes.

HOW TO ENTER: The Sweepstakes begins at 12:01a.m. (Pacific Time [“PT”]) on March 15, 2007 and ends at 11:59 p.m. PT on April 30, 2007 (the “Sweepstakes Period”). There are two ways to enter the Sweepstakes. The total maximum number of entries may be obtained either via Online Entry, Mail Entry or a combination of both Online and Mail Entry:

- 1. Online Entry:** There are three ways to earn entries into the Sweepstakes via the online method of entry.
 - a. Clients (“End Users”) of participating financial institutions will automatically earn one entry into the Sweepstakes by enrolling in Sponsor’s Internet Banking Service during the Sweepstakes Period.
 - b. End Users of participating financial institutions will also automatically earn one entry into the Sweepstakes by enrolling in Sponsor’s Internet Bill Pay Services during the Sweepstakes Period.
 - c. End Users of participating financial institutions will also earn one entry for each qualifying online bill payment made during the Sweepstakes Period. A qualifying online bill payment must be at least \$10.00 or more in value and must be directed to a payee to which there have not been more than one prior payment made during the Sweepstakes Period. Subsequent payments made to a payee during the Sweepstakes Period will not be considered a qualifying online bill payment. Maximum number of additional entries allowed during the Sweepstakes Period is twenty per End User.

The total maximum number of entries allowed per End User during the Sweepstakes Period (earned in any combination of automatic entries received for enrolling in Internet Banking and Internet Bill Pay or via additional entries) is twenty two entries.

- 2. Mail Entry:** On a plain 3” x 5” card, legibly handprint or type your name, age, complete address, city, state, zip code, home and business phone numbers (including area code), email address (if any) and your participating financial institution’s name (if any). Then, mail your 3” x 5” card in a postage-affixed sealed envelope to: “Q1 2007 Internet Banking and Bill Pay End User” Sweepstakes, 1878 East Avenue, Rochester, NY 14610. Mail entries must be postmarked by May 1, 2007 and received by 5:00 p.m. PT on May 9, 2007. A maximum of twenty two entries may be submitted per person during the Sweepstakes Period. No mechanically or programmatically reproduced entries are permitted. Each envelope is considered two entries. Neither the Sponsor nor The National Sweepstakes Company (the “Sweepstakes Administrator”) will verify receipt of entries for entrants. All entries submitted become the sole property of Sponsor and will not be returned. Sponsor is not responsible for lost, late, misdirected, illegible, or damaged mailed entries.

Regardless of the method in which you choose to obtain entries into the Sweepstakes, either via Online Entry, Mail Entry or a combination of the two, the total maximum number of entries allowed during the Sweepstakes Period per person is twenty two entries.

DRAWING & NOTIFICATION: Potential winners will be selected from all eligible entries received and/or credited in a random drawing held on or about May 18, 2007 by Sweepstakes Administrator, an independent judging organization, whose decisions are based on their sole discretion and interpretation of these official rules, (“Official Rules”), and are final and binding in all respects. In the event of uncertainty as to the identity of an entrant, the entrant will be deemed to be the holder of the applicable financial institution account accessed in each applicable Internet Banking Bill Pay session, or in the event there is more than one holder of such account then the first person named on the account shall be deemed to be the entrant, or, if neither is applicable or reasonably ascertainable, the entry may be voided altogether by the Sweepstakes Administrator. Your odds of winning a prize depend on the number of eligible entries received. The potential winners will be notified by phone, email or mail. If a potential winner cannot be reached within seven days from the first notification attempt, then such person shall be disqualified and an alternate winner will be selected. All prizes will be awarded.

PRIZES:

Grand Prize: One (1) Grand Prize of \$10,000 cash will be awarded. The total Approximate Retail Value (the "ARV") of the Grand Prize is \$10,000. The total ARV of all Grand Prizes to be awarded is \$10,000.

Second Prize: Two (2) Second Prizes of \$5,000 cash will be awarded. The total ARV of each Second Prize is \$5,000. The total ARV of all Second Prizes to be awarded is \$10,000.

Third Prize: Three (3) Third Prizes of \$2,500 cash will be awarded. The total ARV of each Third Prize is \$2,500. The total ARV of all Third Prizes to be awarded is \$7,500.

The total ARV of all prizes to be awarded is \$27,500. **Limit of one prize per person/household. Limit of one winner per financial institution.** No prize substitution, except at Sponsor's sole discretion or as otherwise provided herein. Prizes are not transferable prior to award. All taxes on any prize are the sole responsibility of the winner and are not transferable.

PRIZE CONDITIONS: Each potential prize winner will be required to execute an affidavit of eligibility, a liability release and a publicity release and other documents including but not limited to tax documents, as applicable, except where prohibited by law. Such documents must be returned by the date and/or time indicated within such documents. If a potential prize winner fails to return such documents within that time, or if an entrant is found to be ineligible, or if he/she does not comply with the Official Rules, then the potential prize winner will be disqualified and an alternate winner will be selected through a random drawing by the Sweepstakes Administrator from the remaining entries. If the prize or prize notification is returned as undeliverable, this will result in disqualification and an alternate winner will be selected. All federal, state or other tax liabilities (including income taxes) arising from this Sweepstakes will be the sole responsibility of the winner. **Potential winner must report income to the Internal Revenue Service. In the event it is deemed during the verification process that potential winner does not have a unique, personal and valid social security number for Sponsor to report the tax liability associated with acceptance of the prize, potential winner will be disqualified and another winner selected.** Except where prohibited by law, the winner's entry and acceptance of the prize constitutes permission for the Sweepstakes Entities to use said winner's name, photograph, likeness, statements, biographical information and voice on a worldwide basis, and in all forms of media, in perpetuity, without further compensation.

Sweepstakes Entities are not responsible for lost, late, misdirected, undeliverable, illegible, or incomplete entries, whether due to system errors or failures, faulty transmissions or other telecommunications malfunctions, entries not received resulting from any hardware or software failures of any kind, lost or unavailable network connections, failed, incomplete or garbled computer or telephone transmissions, typographical or system errors and failures, faulty transmissions, technical malfunctions, or otherwise. Sponsor may prohibit an entrant from participating in the Sweepstakes or winning a prize if, in its sole discretion, it determines that said entrant is attempting to undermine the legitimate operation of the Sweepstakes by cheating, hacking, deception, or other unfair playing practices (including the use of automated quick entry programs) or intending to annoy, abuse, threaten or harass any other entrants, Sponsor, or Sweepstakes Entities. If for any reason this Sweepstakes is not able to be conducted as planned, including, but not limited to, by reason of infection by computer virus, bugs, tampering, unauthorized intervention, fraud or any other causes beyond the reasonable control of Sponsor or the Sweepstakes Administrator which corrupt or affect the administration, security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct of the promotion, then Sponsor reserves the right at its sole discretion to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the Sweepstakes and randomly draw from those entries received up to the cancellation/suspension date. **CAUTION: ANY ATTEMPT BY AN ENTRANT TO DELIBERATELY DAMAGE OR UNDERMINE THE LEGITIMATE OPERATION OF THE SWEEPSTAKES MAY BE IN VIOLATION OF CRIMINAL AND CIVIL LAWS AND SHOULD SUCH AN ATTEMPT BE MADE, SPONSORS RESERVE THE RIGHT TO SEEK REMEDIES AND DAMAGES (INCLUDING ATTORNEY'S FEES) FROM ANY SUCH ENTRANT TO THE FULLEST EXTENT OF THE LAW, INCLUDING CRIMINAL PROSECUTION.**
